It is a condition of joining the buyback and rent scheme that if the park owner offers seller services, the home owner is required to appoint the park owner to sell the manufactured home under a selling authority (Form 9).

If an **eligible home owner** intends to sell an **eligible manufactured home** and proposes to join the buyback and rent reduction scheme, the home owner must give this completed form to the park owner.

The park owner must, within 7 days of receiving this form, complete the relevant sections of this notice and give a copy to the eligible home owner a notice stating—

- (a) whether the park owner offers services for the sale of manufactured homes in the residential park (seller services); and
- (b) the site rent that will be payable by a new home owner under a site agreement for the site on which the eligible home is positioned.

Eligible home owner means the home owner of a manufactured home that is an eligible manufactured home.

A home is an eligible manufactured home if—

- (a) the manufactured home is positioned on a site in a residential park; and
- (b) the manufactured home was not brought onto the site, or another site in the residential park, by the home owner of the manufactured home or a former home owner of the manufactured home.
